Additional Local Rules

1. **Out of Bounds (Rule 27)**
A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest:
 - a) Beyond any boundary wall or fence.
 - b) Beyond the line of white posts to the rear of holes 5, 9, 10, 11, 14, 16 and 18.
 - c) Beyond the line of white posts to the right of hole 8 which defines the Par. 3 Course.
 - d) Beyond the line of white posts to the left of holes 11 and 17 and to the right of holes 14 and 15 which define the BAPCO pipeline.
 - e) Beyond the white posts and fence that define the driving range to the left of holes 10 and 18.
 2. **Water Hazards (Rule 26-1)**
Water hazards are defined by yellow posts and lateral water hazards are defined by red posts.
Dropping Zone
For a ball coming to rest in the water hazard on hole 2, as an additional option to Rule 26-1, the player may proceed to the dropping zone provided, (located at the front of the blue teeing ground) under penalty of one stroke.
 3. **Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)**
 - a) All artificially surfaced cart paths.
 - b) All windbreak fencing (green cloth fences).
 - c) Drip feed irrigation lines
– Note: Relief is only available for interference to the lie of ball or area of intended swing, NOT stance.
 - d) Floodlight poles – Note: Relief is only available for physical interference to the lie of ball, area
 - of intended swing and stance, NOT intervention on the line of play.
 4. **Movable Obstructions**
Stones in bunkers are to be regarded as moveable obstructions.
 5. **Integral Parts of the Course**
All desert areas and maintenance tracks.
 6. **Doubt as to Procedure (Rule 3-3)**
Any player that has doubt as to procedure may invoke Rule 3-3 (two-ball rule) if a Club Official is not immediately available. He should first state which ball he wishes to score with and must report the facts to the Committee before returning his scorecard.
- General Course Rules**
- a) Golf carts must stay on the cart paths where possible, and must not go within 10 yards of the greens.
 - b) Golf carts are not permitted onto the desert areas unless directed to do so.
 - c) Please repair all ball marks on the greens.
 - d) Please fill all divots with the sand provided.
 - e) Please rake footprints in the bunkers.
 - f) Please place all litter in the waste bins provided.
 - g) Please ensure you keep up with the general pace of play.
- Distance Markers**
- a) All distances are measured in yards.
 - b) The holes are measured from the stone tee markers to the centre of the green.
 - c) The markers on the fairways are to the front of the green.
