Royal Golf Club – Montgomerie Course Additional Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)

A ball is out of bounds when if it comes to rest:

a)Beyond any boundary wall or fence. b)Beyond the white posts to the rear of holes 6, 9, 10, 11, 14 and 16.

c)Beyond the curb on hole 18.

d)Beyond the white posts to the left of holes 11 and 17, and to the right of holes 14 and 15 which define the BAPCO pipe line.

e)A ball which crosses or runs through an Environmentally Sensitive Area / Ground Under Repair and comes to rest beyond that ESA / GUR.

f)Beyond the white posts and fence that define the driving range to the left of holes 10 and 18.

a. Additional stakes have been placed between range poles to assist with this.

2.Water Hazards (Rule 26 - 1)

a)Water hazards are defined by yellow posts and lateral water hazards are defined by red posts. Please see Water Hazards for more information on what relief can be taken.

3. Movable obstructions

a)Stones in bunkers are to be regarded as movable obstructions.

4.Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24

a)All artificially surfaced carts paths. b)All windbreak fencing (green cloth

c)Drip feed irrigation lines – Note: relief is only available for interference to the lie of the ball or area of intended swing, NOT STANCE.

d)Flood light poles – Note: Relief is only available for physical interference to the lie of the ball, area of intended swing and stance, NOT intervention of the line of play.

e)If a player's ball strikes a pole, the player MUST retake shot as close as possible to the ball's original position without penalty. f)All gravel areas.

g)Irrigation cage located on the right side of hole 14. Note: Relief is only available for physical interference to the lie of the ball, area of intended swing and stance, NOT intervention of the line of play. The player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty, When the ball is dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief, the ball must first strike a part of the course at a spot that avoids interference by the immovable obstruction from the physical interference to the lie of the ball, area of intended swing and stance.

5.Hard edges

a)The hard edge border of all desert areas (not hazards) is to be treated as ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in this area, or if it interferes with the player's stance, or the area of their intended swing, the player MUST take relief under Rule 25 – 1. This rule also applies to the hard edge surrounding the mulched tree bowl on hole 15.

6.Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) (Rule 25 – 1)

a)The BAPCO pipe lines that run parallel to holes 8, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15 and 17 are to be treated as an Environmentally Sensitive Area. This area is defined by white posts with green tips. Players are entitled to a free drop one club length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole. A ball which crosses or runs through and ESA / GUR and comes to rest beyond that ESA / GUR is deemed to be out of bounds.
